Temporary Assistant Principal Appointed for Pine View Middle School

Janis Daviston, currently a teacher at Pine View Middle School, was appointed to a one-year position as assistant principal for the school during the 2003-2004 school year. She will serve in the position while former Assistant Principal Mitchell Stubbs serves this year as temporary Principal at Creekside Junior High School.

Revisions to Guidelines for Personnel Evaluation Adopted

Revisions to the Guidelines for Personnel Evaluation were accepted.

Bids for L. P. Monteleone Junior High School Rejected

As recommended by the administration, all bids submitted for the construction of L. P. Monteleone Junior High School were rejected for exceeding the project budget. The project will be re-bid, following architectural modifications to the school plans.

Bids for Clearwood Junior High School Athletic Facility and Parking Addition Accepted

The low Base Bid #1 meeting plans and specifications for the Clearwood Junior High School athletic facility and parking addition was accepted. The low bid of \$340,922 was submitted by TBC, Ltd. The source of funding for the project is the May, 1998, bond authorization.

Fifth Ward Junior High School Classroom and Administrative Building Additions Accepted

The classroom and administrative building (Building A) additions to Fifth Ward Junior High School were accepted as substantially complete, subject to recommendations of the architect, completion of the punch list, and approval of Superintendent Sloan.

Woodlake Elementary School Roofing Project Accepted

The roof removal and replacement project for the Woodlake Elementary School cafeteria was accepted as substantially complete, subject to recommendations of the architect, completion of the punch list, and approval of Superintendent Sloan.

Roofing Project for Slidell Curriculum Center Accepted

The roof removal and replacement project for the Slidell Curriculum Center was accepted

as substantially complete, subject to the recommendations of the architect, completion of the punch list, and approval of Superintendent Sloan.
